## II. DEVELOPMENTS OF NOTE

- **District of Columbia:** The Arson Task Force is investigating <u>four fire incidents</u> that occurred last night between 12:30AM and 2AM in the H Street Corridor and Trinidad areas. The incidents were: an attempt to set fire, an outside fire with serious injuries to an adult male with no fixed address, a car fire, and a front porch fire.
- Montgomery County: At approximately 2AM, 65 firefighters responded to a <u>one-story duplex</u> <u>fire</u> on Edelman Drive in Leisure World, an age-restricted, gated development. Fire & Rescue evaluated one resident.
- Montgomery County: A <u>delivery truck</u> snagged <u>powerlines</u> in Potomac at 3PM yesterday, energizing the vehicle and trapping the driver for 30 minutes before PEPCO arrived. Power was out in the immediate area.

## III. COVID-19 (CORONAVIRUS)

 Overview: Johns Hopkins University reports 4,262,799 COVID-19 cases, 291,981 deaths, and 1,493,661 recoveries worldwide as of 6:15AM. In the US, there are 1,369,964 cases, 82,387 deaths, and 230,287 recoveries.

- National Capital Region: There are 40,014 COVID-19 cases and 1,656 fatalities reported in the NCR. DC, MD, VA
- District of Columbia: In an open source editorial, the Chief of Cardiology at <u>Children's</u> <u>National Hospital</u> (CNH), discussed CNH's investigation of an inflammatory disease affecting children with potential links to COVID-19. Three young patients at CNH have been afflicted by Kawasaki syndrome.
- Maryland: At 5PM, Governor Larry Hogan is expected to provide an update regarding Stage One of Maryland's Roadmap to Recovery.
- Maryland: The <u>Department of Justice</u> has awarded more than \$12.3 million to help public safety agencies in Maryland respond to challenges posed by COVID-19, as part of the Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funding program.
- Charles County: Officials provided a briefing on the establishment of the New Normal Task Force, which is working to develop a safe and gradual plan to operate the government.
- Montgomery County: The County awarded 38 food assistance grants to community groups providing food assistance to vulnerable residents and families. A total of \$1.2 million was appropriated to increase food access during the response to and recovery.
- Virginia: At 2PM, Governor Ralph Northam is expected to provide an update detailing the state's coordination efforts with leaders in Northern Virginia on a plan to delay implementing Phase One until at least May 29.
- Fairfax County: The county Board of Supervisors voted to create the Fairfax Relief Initiative to Support Employers (Fairfax RISE), a new \$25 million grant program to assist small businesses and nonprofits affected by COVID-19. The program will be funded using federal CARES Act funds provided to the county.
