II. DEVELOPMENTS OF NOTE

National Capital Region

District of Columbia: Today, Friday,
 December 6, 2019, environmental activists are
 planning to disrupt targets, such as financial
 institutions in the District. Demonstrators
 activity will impact major traffic arteries near
 the 1800 block of H Street NW and adversely
 impact traffic near Franklin Square in the 1300
 block of I Street NW. Please plan ahead and
 expect delays. Link

United States

 Minnesota: Three soldiers were killed after their National Guard Black Hawk crashed during a flight from an Army aviation facility in St. Cloud, 76 miles from St. Paul. The helicopter lost communication yesterday while it was conducting a maintenance test flight and called mayday roughly nine minutes after takeoff. <u>Link</u>

- New York: One person is dead, and two employees were injured after an explosion on an electrical line in the Bronx. The explosion caused power outages, cancellations, and delays along the Northeast Corridor route. The Amtrak Safety Director does not foresee any long term impacts. Link
- Florida: Four people died in a shootout after a
 failed robbery attempt. Thieves attempted an
 armed robbery at a jewelry store in Coral
 Gables, nearly five miles from Miami. City Hall
 was placed on lockdown after a bullet struck a
 window. The suspects carjacked an UPS truck,
 took the driver hostage, and led police on a
 high-speed chase through multiple counties. It
 is unclear if the UPS truck driver and bystander
 were shot by the thieves or in police crossfire.
