II. DEVELOPMENTS OF NOTE

National Capital Region

- Arlington County: The Heights Building, which hosts two schools and administrative offices, will be closed today due to an accidental break in a sprinkler line caused by a contactor. Families will be notified by 6PM today regarding the operating status for Wednesday, February 19. <u>Link</u>
- District of Columbia: FEMS responded to a fatal fire in the 4800 block of 10 Street NE at two-story duplex. The fire was discovered by a unit going to obtain fuel.

- Charles County: All southbound lanes of US-301/Crain Highway at Mitchell Road were closed for five hours overnight due to a motor vehicle collision. All lanes have reopened.
- Montgomery County: All westbound lanes of I-495 prior to exit 29/University Blvd/MD-193 were closed for several hours overnight due to a multi-vehicle accident. All lanes have reopened.
- NCR: Employees of regional Giant and Safeway stores plan for a potential strike over wages, healthcare, and work pensions. A rally and press conference to announce the date for a potential strike vote is scheduled for tomorrow, February 19. <u>Link</u>

United States

Arizona: A White Mountain Apache police
officer was shot and killed while responding to
reports of shots fired at a casino in Pinetop Lakeside, 180 miles east of Phoenix. The
officer and the suspect engaged in a violent
physical altercation when the officer was shot.
A second officer arrived and shot the male
suspect. This is the state's eleventh officer involved shooting this year. Link

- Overview: Johns Hopkins University's Center for Systems Science and Engineering reports 73,336 confirmed cases of COVID-19 and 1,874 deaths as of 2/18/2020 at 6:03AM. <u>Link</u>
