II. DEVELOPMENTS OF NOTE

National Capital Region

 District of Columbia: Seventy-five firefighters responded to a 2-alarm fire at a three-story building on the 1500 block of Church Street NW. The fire was on the top floor and worsened when a propane tank on the building's roof exploded. Nine people were displaced. Link

- District of Columbia: The Washington
 Monument was closed for three hours after the
 system that allows park rangers access to the
 elevator controls lost power. <u>Link</u>
- Fairfax County: A potential breach at a
 neighboring police department may have
 compromised the personal information of over
 500 county police department employees. A
 memory stick that contained data of the
 employees and the email inbox of the
 Purcellville police chief is missing. It is
 unknown if any officers' personal information
 has been exploited. <u>Link</u>

United States

 Colorado: Twenty-six children were found behind a false wall in a day care in Colorado Springs. Police visited the day care after receiving complaints that the business was housing more children than its license allowed. The state's Department of Human Services suspended the day care license. Link

World

- Switzerland: Dozens of climate activists
 blocked access to the private jet terminal at
 Geneva Airport, demanding a halt to the
 "absurd" mode of luxury transportation. Nearly
 100 people took part of the unauthorized, yet
 peaceful protest. Activists sat in front of three
 entrances to block access to the terminal for
 several hours. Police monitored and cordoned
 the area. No commercial flights were disrupted.

- Bangladesh: At least seven people were killed and 25 injured after a gas pipeline exploded in Chittagong, 134 miles southeast of Dhaka. The pipeline exploded in front of a five-story building. The cause of the explosion is unknown. Link
