## **United States**

- Nationwide: The Centers of Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) is monitoring travelers arriving to the US from China at 20 US airports that have quarantine stations. The immediate risk of transmission remains low for the general public. <u>Link</u>
- Maryland: The Maryland Department of Health today reported that a Maryland resident met CDC criteria for testing for 2019-nCoV. This individual is in good condition and is being monitored while awaiting test results by the CDC laboratory. <u>Link</u>
- Virginia: There are no confirmed cases currently. The Department of Health announced the two patients under investigation tested negative for 2019-nCoV. Test results for the third patient under investigation are expected later this week. <u>Link</u>
- California: San Francisco activated its Emergency Operation Center to monitor and respond to 2019-nCov threats. The city has no cases. A hospital is on standby if needed. San Francisco International Airport has cancelled all outbound flights out of Wuhan. Link
- California: Ontario International Airport, 55
  miles east of Los Angeles International Airport,
  is working with state partners to charter a flight
  carrying US government officials and private
  citizens back to the US from Wuhan, China.
  The facility is taking steps to minimize risk to
  other travelers, staff, and the community. Link

## Global

- South Korea: US Forces Korea cautioned Americans to take precautionary measures after a case of 2019-nCoV was found near two US military bases. Link
- China: The US State Department raised its travel advisory to "Level 3: Reconsider Travel" due to 2019-nCoV. <u>Link</u>
