I. WEATHER

- **Today:** Rain, mainly after 7AM. Chance of precipitation is 80%. High 53°. Low 47°.



II. DEVELOPMENTS OF NOTE

National Capital Region

- **Montgomery County:** A vehicle crash into a home involving two cars left one person dead and four others injured in Germantown. First responders found a Toyota Scion FR-S projecting out of the carport of a single-story home when the vehicle caught fire. The home was unoccupied at the time of the crash. [Link](#)

- **District of Columbia:** Police arrested a 25 year-old male outside the White House after carrying a knife and making threats to do bodily harm. The male told a Secret Service officer patrolling outside the White House he was there to assassinate the President. He was taken to a hospital for a mental health evaluation. [Link](#)

United States

- **New York:** An individual was arrested in connection to two separate shootings that targeted law enforcement officers in the Bronx. Two police officers were shot less than 12 hours apart and in locations separated by a few blocks, including a precinct and a police van. The mayor and police commissioner are describing the incidents as assassination attempts. [Link](#)
- **Mississippi:** A mother and her six children died in a house fire in Clinton. Investigators are looking into why the mother and her children were unable to escape. Foul play is not suspected. The cause of the fire is under investigation. [Link](#)

World

- **Europe:** Storm Ciara swept in with heavy rains and wind speeds of 93 mph prompting the cancellation of transportation services and leaving 62,000 customers without power. More than 170 flood warnings remain in place. Some buildings were damaged but there was no report of casualties. [Link](#)
