II. DEVELOPMENTS OF NOTE

National Capital Region

- **District of Columbia:** The Washington Nationals will visit the White House today to celebrate their World Series win. The ceremony will reportedly take place on the South Lawn at 1:15PM. [Link](#)

United States

- **Louisiana:** A ruptured vessel caused an explosion at a Dow chemical plant that rattled windows in nearby homes. There are no reported injuries. The affected production unit was shut down. Officials report there is no immediate danger to the public. [Link](#)
- **Delaware:** A crash involving a car and fuel truck that left one dead shut down US-13/Sussex Highway in Bridgeville in both directions for four hours. The fuel truck overturned landing upside down and spilled 3000 gallons of diesel fuel. The crash remains under investigation. [Link](#)
- **Maryland:** Police are investigating five “kill lists” that could be considered threats of mass violence found at an Annapolis middle school. The lists appeared to be written by a student and were discovered in books and written on restroom walls. [Link](#)

- **California:** All evacuations orders have been lifted for the southern region after firefighters made progress compressing hotspots. Firefighters have contained 50 percent of the blaze. The cause of the fires is still under investigation. [Link](#)
- **California:** An off-duty police officer killed his friend, another police officer, and injured his father before killing himself. The shooting happened in Hanford, 33 miles south of Fresno. Authorities report the two men were shot after intervening in a fight during a birthday party. [Link](#)

World

- **Hong Kong:** Riot police rushed several malls in a move to prevent more anti-democracy protests when a knife-wielding man slashed five people and bit off part of the ear of a local politician outside the Cityplaza mall in Taikoo Shing. The attacker was beaten by the crowd until police arrived. The incident is under investigation. [Link](#)

- **Nepal:** An overcrowded bus drove off a highway and into a river, killing 17 and injuring another 50. The bus appeared to have a mechanical problem before skidding off the highway. Poorly maintained vehicles and mountain roads are often to blame for bus accidents in Nepal. [Link](#)
