II. DEVELOPMENTS OF NOTE

National Capital Region

- Prince George's County: Police responded to a <u>fatal pedestrian collision</u> near the intersection of St. Barnabas Road and Dallas Road. All travel lanes are open.
- Fairfax County: Firefighters responded to a vehicle crash of a truck that drove through a retaining wall onto the beltway ramp near Braddock Road yesterday. No injuries were reported.

United States

 California: Eleven firefighters were injured in an <u>explosion</u> at a hash oil manufacturer last night in Los Angeles. The cause of the fire is under investigation.

III. COVID-19 (CORONAVIRUS)

- Overview: <u>Johns Hopkins University</u> reports 4,650,793 COVID-19 cases, 312,115 deaths, and 1,699,843 recoveries worldwide as of 6:16AM. In the US, there are 1,467,884 cases, 88,754 deaths, and 268,376 recoveries.
- National Capital Region: There are 45,036 COVID-19 cases and 1,864 fatalities reported in the NCR. <u>DC</u>, <u>MD</u>, <u>VA</u>
- Nationwide: The FDA approved a COVID-19 <u>at-home sample collection kit</u> for individuals who have been screened using an online questionnaire that is reviewed by a health care provider.
- City of Alexandria: A community <u>COVID-19</u> testing pilot was initiated yesterday in an effort to expand and provide testing to residents who do not exhibit symptoms.
- Prince William County: Beginning Monday, May 18, drive-thru and walk-up <u>COVID-19</u> <u>testing</u> will be available at two locations.
