II. DEVELOPMENTS OF NOTE

III. COVID-19 (CORONAVIRUS)

- Overview: Johns Hopkins University reports 4,040,289 COVID-19 cases, 279,565 deaths, and 1,380,716 recoveries worldwide as of 6:21AM. In the US, there are 1,309,541 cases, 78,794 deaths, and 212,534 recoveries. Link
- National Capital Region: There are 36,522 COVID-19 cases and 1,515 fatalities reported in the NCR. <u>DC</u>, <u>MD</u>, <u>VA</u>
- Nationwide: Beginning Wednesday May 13,
 Delta will temporarily consolidate their service
 at 10 stations in markets served by multiple
 airports. Delta will continue to provide essential
 service to impacted communities via

- Virginia: The Department of Social Services will provide Pandemic EBT benefits to families of school-age children who no longer have access to meals due to public school closures. <u>Link</u>
