


# NCR WATCH DESK

## I. WEATHER

#### II. DEVELOPMENTS OF NOTE

### **National Capital Region**

- National Capital Region: Effective July 7, Yellow and Green line customers should allow additional travel time through mid-July; as Metro performs around-the-clock track work along segments of these lines, including 7-14 day closures of selected stations.
- Maryland: Anne Arundel County Fire
   <u>Department</u> responded to a structural collapse in the 8300 block of Dunn Road when a large tree fell on a detached garage. Six people were extricated and a total of 21 patients were transported.

## III. COVID-19 (CORONAVIRUS)

- Overview: Johns Hopkins University reports 11,470,637 COVID-19 cases, 534,784 deaths, and 6,189,108 recoveries worldwide as of 6AM. In the US, there are 2,888,729 cases, 129,947 deaths, and 906,763 recoveries.
- National Capital Region: There are 81,681 COVID-19 cases and 3,108 fatalities reported in the NCR. <u>DC</u>, <u>MD</u>, <u>VA</u>
- District of Columbia: Today, Mayor Muriel Bowser is expected to provide a <u>COVID-19</u> <u>update</u> at 11 AM.
- Maryland: Montgomery County Recreation will open seven outdoor pools and three aquatic centers today, as part of the County's Phase II reopening. Pools will be open to pass-holders only.
- Charles County: Beginning July 13, the
   Department of Recreation, Parks, and Tourism
   offices will be open to the public on a limited
   basis. Office hours are 8 AM until 4:30 PM.
   Appointments, face masks and health
   screening completions are required for all
   visitors.
- Virginia: Fairfax County Public Schools will host a virtual Town Hall today, from 6:30 until 7:30 PM. Questions will be answered about the return to school options for the 2020-21 School Year. On July 8, a Spanish language virtural Town Hall will be held.
- Prince William County: The <u>School Board will</u>
   hold a <u>special meeting</u> on July 7, at 6 PM for
   the purpose of listening to citizen comments
   regarding school reopening to address critical
   matters created by the state of emergency and
   COVID-19 pandemic.
