 Prince George's County: Fire and EMS units responded to the I-495/Beltway Inner Loop ramp to eastbound US-50/John Hanson Hwy (#19) for a tractor trailer fire. The fire is out, no injuries or transports. The ramp remains blocked.

III. COVID-19 (CORONAVIRUS)

- National Capital Region: There are 72,859 COVID-19 cases and 2,756 fatalities reported, in the NCR. DC, MD, VA
- National: The <u>FDA has issued a warning letter</u> to EUCYT Laboratories, LLC, for marketing an unapproved exosome product for the treatment or prevention of COVID-19. Currently, there are no FDA approved products to prevent or treat COVID-19.
- National: The Federal Government has announced the distribution of nearly 100 million cloth facial coverings in the aviation, transit, and passenger rail transportation sectors for passenger use.
- District of Columbia: The U.S. Department of Veteran's Affairs reported the status of COVID-19 patients of the District's VA Medical Center as of June 12: 498 cumulative confirmed COVID-19 cases, 63 active cases, 387 convalescent cases, and 48 known deaths.
- Frederick County: The Health Department
 has announced to residents that an <u>at home</u>
 testing kit from Labcorp is available to order
 online for no upfront cost, in an effort to make
 testing available to anyone who cannot access
 existing testing options within the community.
- Loudoun County: Childcare Services and outdoor-only fitness programs (select community and recreation centers) and athletic fields will <u>reopen</u> on June 15.
