


NCR WATCH DESK

I. WEATHER

 Today: Scattered showers and thunderstorms after 2 PM. Partly sunny. Chance of precipitation is 50%. High 91°. Low 74°.



II. DEVELOPMENTS OF NOTE

National Capital Region

- National Capital Region: The National
 Weather Service issued Flood Watches and
 Warnings overnight for several areas in the
 NCR. Damaging winds and heavy rain caused
 power outages.
- Prince George's County: Fire and EMS units responded to a <u>water rescue</u> in the 400 block of Old Ritchie Road. Crews rescued five adults trapped by floods, one of which required EMS Services.

United States


 Indiana: <u>Two people</u> were struck by a vehicle during a demonstration in Bloomington, 51 miles from the capital of Indianapolis. Crowds gathered at Lake Monroe where a man was pinned down.

- Overview: Johns Hopkins University reports 11,641,640 COVID-19 cases, 538,539 deaths, and 6,320,890 recoveries worldwide as of 6AM. In the US, there are 2,938,624 cases, 130,306 deaths, and 924,148 recoveries.
- National Capital Region: There are 82,143
 COVID-19 cases and 3,120 fatalities reported
 in the NCR. <u>DC</u>, <u>MD</u>, <u>VA</u>
- National: Healthcare Workers are invited to join the CDC on Thursday at 8 AM for the latest COVID-19 <u>Infection and Prevention</u> <u>Control Global webinar series</u>.
- District of Columbia: During yesterday's
 <u>COVID-19 update</u>, Mayor Bowser states the
 curve in the District has been flattened, while
 emphasizing that the virus has not yet been
 eradicated.
