I. WEATHER

II. DEVELOPMENTS OF NOTE

National Capital Region

Prince George's County: Fire and EMS
responded to the 6000 blk of 34th Ave in
Hyattsville for a two-story house fire. One adult
occupant had self-evacuated. One firefighter
was transported to the hospital for evaluation.

 Montgomery County: County Detectives are asking for the public's assistance in locating a missing <u>25-year-old Rockville man</u> due to concern for his physical and emotional welfare.

III. COVID-19 (CORONAVIRUS)

- Overview: <u>Johns Hopkins University</u> reports 5,606,925 COVID-19 cases, 350,862 deaths, and 2,301,727 recoveries worldwide as of 6AM. In the US, there are 1,681,418 cases, 98,929 deaths, and 384,902 recoveries.
- National Capital Region: There are 57,809
 COVID-19 cases and 2,286 fatalities reported in the NCR. DC, MD, VA
- Virginia: The Governor amended <u>Executive</u> <u>Order Fifty-One</u>, extending the state's emergency declaration.
- City of Alexandria: On May 28 at 5PM, the city, in partnership with World Central Kitchen, will distribute meals and groceries at Ramsay Elementary School.
- Fairfax County: As of May 25, Fire and Rescue (FCFRD) reports seven personnel have tested positive for COVID-19. Fourteen have recovered while six remain in quarantine. FCFRD continues to fully staff all stations and apparatus.
- Prince William County: On June 12 at 4:30PM, <u>Public Schools</u> will open registration for its elementary and middle school programs. Due to COVID-19, there will be no late or onsite registration. The Summer School Office will provide all programs to families by June 24.
